3	<b>Guest speaker</b>	Local historian Jahan Mahmood will speak to year 8 students about life in world war 1 with a focus on Coventry	<b>SMA</b>	This will be repeated with Y8 groups each year, for the next four years.
4	<b>History Curriculum</b>	As part of their History curriculum, students in Year 8 will study World War 1. They will learn about the causes, key events, outcomes and consequences of the Great War. They will also learn about the role of women, people of all faiths and the countries that make up the Commonwealth.	<b>SMA</b>	This will be a permanent part of the History curriculum and will be repeated with the year 8 groups each year.
5	<b>WW1 Commemoration Assembly</b>	ARMISTICE DAY ASSEMBLY and minutes silence	<b>Heads of years</b>	This will be repeated each year, for the next four years.
6	<b>WW1 Exhibition</b>	Through their enrichment activity, Students will prepare and display a World War 1 Exhibition. The exhibition will have artefacts, displays, video clips etc. which raise awareness of WW1. The exhibition will be open to students and the wider community and local primary schoolchildren.	<b>SSMA</b>	The exhibition will be repeated each year, for the next four years.
7	<b>100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary Tours</b>	A group of students from across Tauheedul schools will visit battlefields on the Western Front, such as the Somme, Verdun and Fromelles. <a href="http://www.centenarybattlefieldtours.org">http://www.centenarybattlefieldtours.org</a> .
