Dear parent

Assalaamu Alaikum (May Peace Be With You)

I am writing to confirm arrangements for the forthcoming Eid holidays.

School will be closed for two days to allow for all students, staff and their families to celebrate Eid.

The timing of our two-day holiday will depend on the sighting of the moon.

If the moon is sighted on the evening of Monday 4th July, then school will close on Tuesday 5th July and Wednesday 6th July. All students will be expected to return to school on Thursday 7th July.

If the moon is **not** sighted on Monday 4th July, then school will run as normal on Tuesday 5th July. Instead, school will close on Wednesday 6th July and Thursday 7th July. All students will be expected to return to school on Friday 8th July.

In addition, please note that on the first day back after the Eid holidays:

- It will be a non-uniform day. Students should dress modestly and jewellery is not allowed.
- Students are encouraged to bring a small amount of sweet (in a container that they can use to bring leftover food back home) to share with their form class.
- There will be normal lessons for the rest of the day, so students should bring their stationery and books as usual.

Please contact the school and ask to speak to your daughter's Head of Year if you have any queries about the Eid holiday.

I would like to thank you for your continued support and ask for your special prayers for our school family and community during these final few days of the holy month of Ramadhaan.
