



Dear Parents / Carers of Year 10 Students,

Thank you for returning the consent forms for your daughter for the 2017 Activities Week and the Rewards Trip. In order for her to get the best experience out of each of the activities she will be involved in we have laid out below the dress code allowed along with the requirement for a packed lunch and the rules on mobile phones for each day.

If you have not given permission for your daughter to go on the external school trips, then she will be expected to be in school those days and attend lessons in full school uniform. Students who are not going on the Thursday trips must bring their PE kit in on Thursday 6th July.

If your daughter is in receipt of Free School Meals the school will provide a packed lunch for both the Geography or History and Theme Park trips. She will not require a packed lunch on Thursday as we will return to school in time for lunch.

Should we experience another heatwave on the trip days then your daughter may wish to bring sun cream and/or suitable head protection on those days. Please also ensure she brings a re-fillable water bottle to prevent dehydration.

If your daughter has a medical condition please make certain she has her medication with her on the trip days.

This will be especially important if she has asthma that can be brought on by heat or physical exertion e.g. walking to and from Coventry University.

Your daughter will be given an emergency contact number on the morning of the trip days. She will be asked to enter this into her mobile phone (if she has one) in case she needs to contact a member of staff urgently during the day.
