This month, especially, is one in which we should be grateful for the countless bounties bestowed upon us by the Almighty. It is a time for giving and gaining extra, as the reward for each good action is multiplied. It is also an opportunity to remember those in our country and around the world whose lives are blighted by poverty, conflict and disease.

The noble Prophet Muhammad (Peace Be Upon Him) said: *“The best charity is given in Ramadhan.”*

This year, we are working in partnership with Tauheedul Charity to provide Eid gifts to children in Syria at the end of Ramadhan.
