Geography Trip Thursday 19th July 2018

Pupils will be out of school for the entire day. The AQA specification requires that students complete two geographical enquiries during the course. Students will complete two environmental surveys of contrasting urban streets. One in an area of Kidderminster and the other in Bewdley. If students miss this opportunity it would disadvantage them in the GCSE exam.

The school has arranged for pupils to take lunch in a church hall in the town. Toilet facilities will also be available here. As there is a lot of walking involved, please ensure students have weather appropriate outdoor clothing and footwear on the day.
