Year 11 Mock Exams: 30th November to 11th of December.

As you may be aware, this year the grades from internal assessments may be used to inform the final grade for each examination subject if final exams cannot take place due to Covid-19. Therefore, this year the internal assessments have much more significance than previous years.

The Autumn 2 Mock Assessment programme starts on **Monday the 30th November and runs until 11th of December**. The timetable for assessments is included on the back of this letter. Please ensure that you keep this in a prominent place so that you can ensure that your daughter prepares properly for her assessments.

It is important that students spend time revising and preparing for assessments and in order to do this they should be spending at least 2 hours per night revising. Staff at the school will have provided students with lists of topics and content to revise and students should ensure that they have their books/notes in order to do this.

On the day of examinations, students should ensure that they come to school properly equipped, and this includes the relevant exercise books and textbooks for the subjects being examined.

If you collect your daughter from school, please note that on some days she may be slightly late leaving school if assessments over run.
