Year 10 Assessment Autumn 1

The Autumn 1 Assessment programme starts on **Monday the 4th of October and runs until 15th of October**. Religious Studies, Computer Studies, Health and Social Care plus Creative Imedia will be externally assessed in 2022. Like last year, this year the grades from the internal assessments may be used to inform the final grade for the subjects if final exams cannot take place due to Covid-19. **Therefore, this year the internal assessments for the above subjects have much more of significance.**

The timetable for these assessments can be found below.

Monday 4 th October Period 4	Computer Science: Paper 1 and 2 (Mixed Paper) (50 min)
Monday 4 th October Period 3 or Period 4	Religious Studies: 1) Islamic Practices 2) Religion, Peace and Conflict 50 mins
Tuesday 5 th October Period 5	Creative Imedia: Theory Paper (45 min)
Wednesday 6 th October Period 4	Health and Social Care: Theory Paper (60 min)

Please note, all Year 10 students will undertake assessments for every GCSE subject they study for this half term. For the other assessments not listed above, subject teachers will notify students of the timing of the assessments. It is important that students spend time revising and preparing for assessments and in order to do this they should be spending at least 2 hours per night revising. Staff at the school will have provided students with lists of topics and content to revise and students should ensure that they have their books/notes in order to do this.

On the day of examinations, students should ensure that they come to school properly equipped, and this includes the relevant exercise books and textbooks for the subjects being examined.

If you collect your daughter from school, please note that on some days she may be slightly late leaving school if assessments over run.
