Ramadhaan holds a special significance in the Muslim calendar. At Eden we believe that supporting our students with inspiring activities will allow them to maximise the potential of this incredible time as well as use the opportunity to learn something new and reconnect with their faith. These activities are an integral part of our holistic FCE offer and students and staff are encouraged to take the time to take part in them during Ramadhaan.

Activity	Description
Ramadhaan Good Character Challenge	During form time, students are encouraged to explore themes of character development inspired through Quranic verses. Students are encouraged to implement the suggested activity.
Good deed calendar	Students are encouraged to think about the smallest acts of kindness that they can adopt each day.
Ramadhaan planner	Each student will be provided with a special Ramadhaan planner to support them in organising their time to incorporate faith and spirituality into their day along with schoolwork and helping their families at home.
Qur'aan 30 days- 30 chapters	Each day, a short PowerPoint summarising the main lessons, morals and stories of the Quran will be shared on Teams and on display screens within school. Students are encouraged to share this with their families.
Ramadhaan lunch circles-	Students are invited to spend their lunchtime in the Reflection Hall during Ramadhaan: Quran , come along and recite your Ramadhaan Quran Come to learn how to read Quran.

Quran and Dhikr, virtues of Ramadhaan	<p>Dhikr- come to enjoy the peace and serenity. Join in quiet dhikr, durood etc</p> <p>Silent Reflection- come and enjoy the peace and tranquillity this special space has to offer</p> <p>Virtues of Ramadhaan-once a week per year group. Learn about the virtues of Ramadhaan through a short naseehah (talk) from the Hadeeth.</p>
Live feed from Makkah with Nasheeds	Keep up to date with what is happening in Masjid-ul-Haram in Makkah and feel the ambiance.
Purple Lanterns- Keeping up with Eden	Leadership students will be sharing their discussions on Ramadhaan; their experiences, tips on surviving school whilst fasting etc. A weekly link will be shared via MS TEAMS
Spirited Art competition	Students are encouraged to create an Art piece inspired by a Quranic verse or theme. This piece of Art can take any form such as a 3D model, poster etc.
Eid Card competition	Each year students have an opportunity to create an Eid card design. The best Eid card design will be used as the official Eden Eid card.
Eid Celebration Meal	<p>Each year, the school treats all staff and students to a special celebratory Eid meal. The date for the Eid meal is Thursday 5th May 2022.</p> <p>Students will be able to swap Eid cards with their friends if they wish to do so.</p>
Ramadhaan Charity Appeal	<p>Ramadhaan is a month for giving and gaining extra, as the reward for each good action is multiplied. It is also an opportunity to remember those in our country and around the world whose lives are blighted by poverty, conflict and illness.
