Dear Parents/Guardians

In order to have a **safe** and **happy** school and help students to develop their character and achieve the best possible grades, excellent behaviour and attitude is crucial. The school expects all students to **behave well** at all times, treat others with **respect**, and ensure that they **do not disrupt the learning** of other students.

The policy identifies:

- Rewards for positive behaviours so that pupils know that excellent learning and character is valued.
- Support and guidance for pupils who struggle to behave well consistently.
- Consistent consequences for 'disruptive' and 'red line' (serious) behaviours.

Disruptive Behaviour	Red Line Behaviour
 First time - 'Whisper correction' (subtle warning) Second time - same day detention and 2 points on Class Charts. Third time - removal from lesson and referral to Reflection (3 points on Class Charts) 	 Immediate referral to Reflection Room. Suspension from school. (4 points on Class Charts)

Please support our efforts by encouraging your child to try their best with each of our expectations.

We understand the importance of keeping you informed about your child's behaviour while they are at school. To facilitate this, we encourage you to download the Class Charts Parents app because this is the way we will inform you if your child has a same day detention. This app will be updated regularly, allowing you to see whether your child has been assigned a same-day detention, along with the positive points she has been given too. We have included a reminder on how to access Class Charts below.
